



# How to Log-In to MyEducation

Navigate to the following link from any internet connected computer:  
<https://www.myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspen/logon.do>

## #1

- Enter your **Login ID** (PEN# - Personal Education Number)
- Enter the auto generated password provided **OR** the password you have created (**The password is CASE SENSITIVE**)
- **Forgot your password?** Click on “I forgot my password”, it will email you a temporary password to email you provided
