Important Information for Parents/Guardians:

- 1. Spectators/Visitors:** All spectators and visitors will be expected to follow the CDP. In alignment with SD22 Board Office and regional health measures, the EAA will expect **"one spectator per child athlete to be in attendance"**. *We ask families with multiple spectators to coordinate who will attend each event to ensure one spectator per athlete.*
- 2. Expectations for Spectators:**
 - **Sign the Visitor Binder-** Host schools will have a Visitor Binder that includes a copy of SD22 CDP and visitor sign in sheets on a desk by the door entering the gym.
 - All visitors will need to **wear a mask, sanitize upon entry, and space out where possible** in designated spectator areas in each gym. Please DO NOT crowd the entry OR gather in groups.
- 3. Carpooling/Travel:** Student athletes and their families are expected to follow the CDP guidelines for travel (Pg. 6): *"Spread out in the vehicle as much as possible, and travel with the same people whenever possible. Practice good hand hygiene and clean frequently touched surfaces. Set the vehicles' ventilation to bring in fresh outside air, and open windows when the weather permits. Wear masks as outlined in this document."*
- 4. Athlete etiquette upon entering the host school:**
 - Coaches should bring the team in as a group (wait outside the building to ensure similar time arrival)
 - Athletes need to sanitize before entry into the gym.
 - Athletes are expected to wear masks until they start their physical activity.
 - Players that are not on the court during the game play are expected to wear a mask.
 - Athletes need to sanitize their hands upon departure (due to shared equipment)
 - Athletes are encouraged to bring their own water bottle and not to share with others.
- 5. End of Season Tournaments:** At this point in time, we are able to have smaller season ending tournaments. Currently the EAA is looking at family of schools tournaments. This would feature a maximum of 3 teams. As rules and restrictions change, we will need to adjust and adapt accordingly. Further information regarding end of season tournaments will be communicated at a later date.
