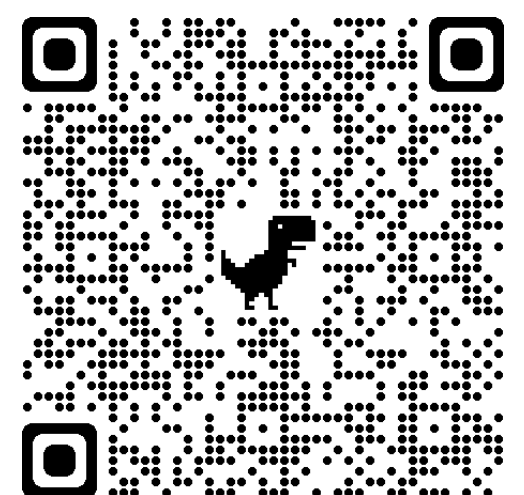

What is the Equity Scan?

Equity is ensuring every learner what they need to be successful.

The Equity Scan is a process that works to identify and address barriers that may impact Indigenous student success and achievement.

Why is SD22 conducting an Equity Scan?

Student data reveals gaps in achievement in the areas of literacy, numeracy, and graduation for Indigenous learners. The Equity Scan will help us to better understand the experience of Indigenous learners in our district to improve educational outcomes.

Who participates in the Equity Scan?

In the 2020/2021 school year, the Vernon School District has joined Equity in Action with 15 other school districts across the province. In SD22, we are asking for participation in an online survey from all stakeholder groups, including:

- SD22 staff
- Indigenous students
- Indigenous parents/guardians
- Indigenous community members

How is the Equity Scan Conducted?

Representatives from each stakeholder group were invited to develop the Equity Scan questions which have been used in the online surveys. These stakeholder representatives will use the findings of the Equity Scan surveys to create an Action Plan to improve the experience of Indigenous learners in our district.
