- **Your selections build the Seaton timetable**
 - **The timetable is built based on student requests**
- **Pick thoughtful alternatives in case you don't get your first choice**
- **Courses need enough students selecting them to be offered**
- **No guarantee we can change your schedule at a later date**

What do you need in Grade 10?

- **All students must take 8 courses**
 - *2-3 alternative choices*
 - French Immersion students can select 5 courses in French
- **Choose carefully, the timetable is created based on your selections**
- **Pick thoughtful alternates in case you don't get your first choice**

Grade 10 Course Selection

Required Courses

1. Language Arts 10 (2 courses – Lit. Studies 10 plus 1 more Lang. Arts 10)
2. Social Studies 10 (French/English)
3. Math 10 (French/English- pick one)
4. Science 10 (French/English)
5. PE 10 (pick one)
6. Career Life Education (French/English)
7. 2 choice electives

** Ministry Numeracy and Literacy Assessment written in gr. 10

**A Fine Arts or Applied skills course must be taken at least once between gr. 10-12

Student Choice Elective Courses

- Languages – French 10, Okanagan 10
(French Immersion Students are required to take FRAL 10)
- Fine Arts Elective:
 - (Concert Band 10, Visual Arts 10, Drama 10, Theatre Company 10, Musical Theatre 10, Theatre Production 10)

- Literary Studies 10 (2 credits)

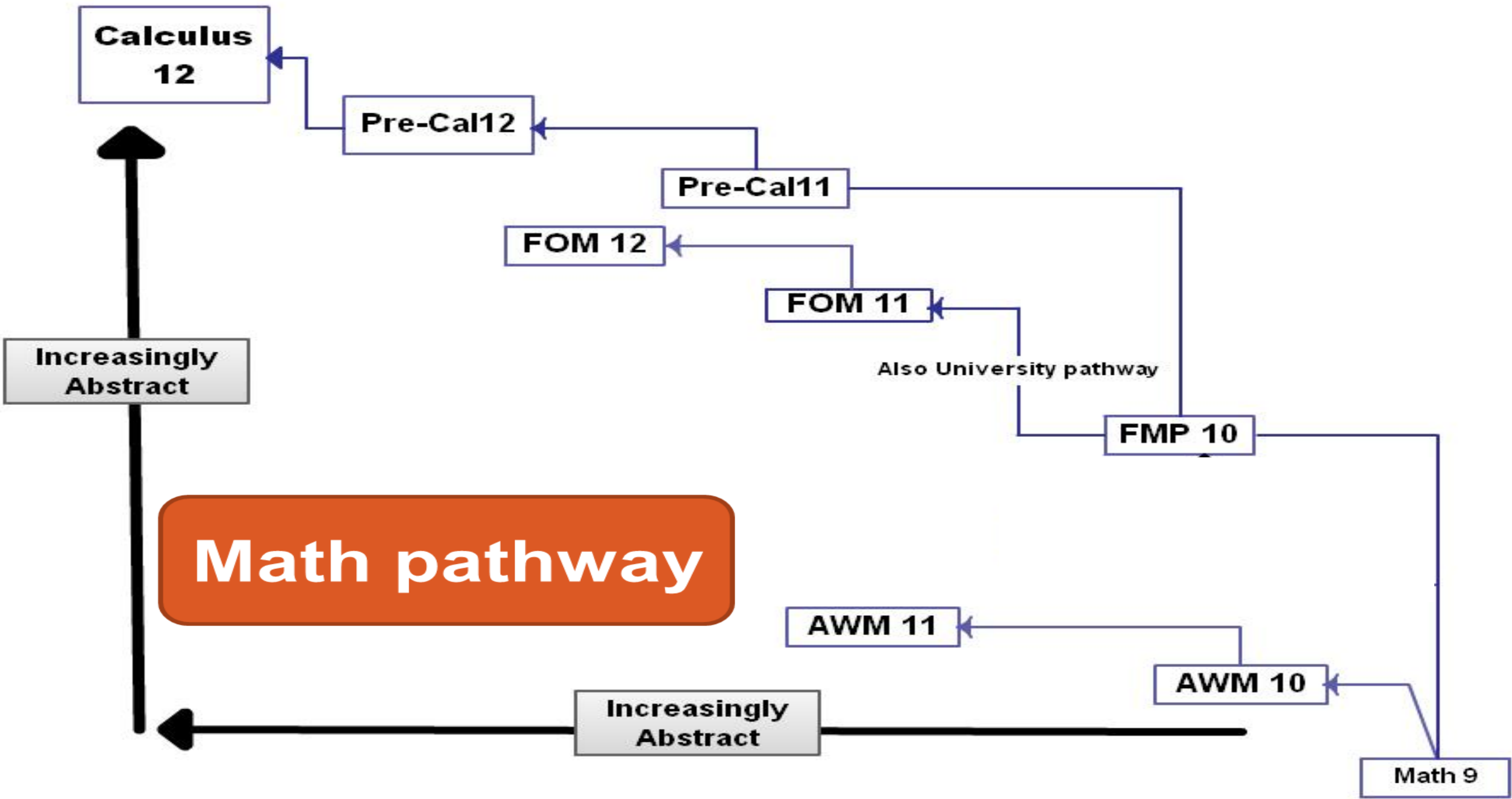

Math Choice

- **AWM 10**...*Apprenticeship & Workplace*
 - *Practical application of math concepts*
 - *Many post secondary options available from this stream*

- **FMP 10**...*Foundations & Pre-Calculus*
 - *University stream*
 - *Science, Business, Health related fields*
 - *Recommended 65% or better in Math 9*



Electives

- These are your “choice” classes.
- Choose your electives carefully as we will not run all of these electives.
- We run elective courses based on the number of students who request them. If there are not enough students selecting a course it may not run next year.
- Selecting alternate choices is important.

New courses

- **Self and Society 11**
- focuses on human development; examining self-perception, values, attitudes, beliefs and emotional responses.

- Students will examine the importance of self-awareness, social awareness, self-management and relationships.
