Students will begin to work on DELF activities in preparation for the optional exam in grade 12.

Using the scientific method as well as various methods of inquiry, the scope of topics include: 1. The cell. 2. The atom and the kinetic molecular theory. 3. Energy as a particle and a wave. 4. The theory of plate tectonics.

The Big Ideas for the content focuses on how changing ideas about the world created tension between people wanting to adapt new ideas, and those wanting to preserve established traditions. Exploration, expansion and colonisation and the activities brought significant change culturally, politically, and socially. Human and environmental factors that have shaped changes in population and living standards during this time period will also be examined.
MADDL08	DIGITAL LITERACY 8 - ADST	Applied Skills	08	In this course students explore elements of digital citizenship, ethical and legal implications of current and future technologies, and strategies to engage in safe search results online. Students will have opportunities to create personal digital content as well as review online communications and resources. Implications of cyber bullying, online etiquette, and online communities will be discussed. Digital Literacy 8 is part of the grade 8 applied design skills and tech rotational courses.

Grade 8 Nsyilxcen is open to all students, including those with no previous experience with the Nsyilxcen language. This course meets the second language requirements for Grade 8. Grand 9 students are also welcome to take this course. This course will be offered if a qualified instructor is available.
