Dual Credit students are enrolled in college programs during high school and receive both high school and college credits. Students attend Okanagan College with college instructors at a campus in Vernon, Kelowna, Salmon Arm or Penticton, depending on the program and the start date.

Planning starts ideally at least a year in advance for these programs. It is best to start planning in Grade 10 or at the beginning of Grade 11, to ensure that prerequisites are arranged, because of competitive and limited seat availability at OC.

**School District #22 will sponsor the tuition and you will not be required to pay the tuition fees.**

**You will be expected to pay the ancillary fees as well as any costs for student materials.**

- Grade 11 (ideally second half - summer of grade 12)
- Grade 12 first semester
